JUNK MAIL

MATTRESSES, FURNITURE AND REUSABLE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Recycle or donate your used mattress, furniture and other household items. Donated items must be clean and unstained. More information at auburnwa.gov/solidwaste click on Waste Prevention, the Donate & Reuse (menu at left).



TORN OR DAMAGED CLOTHES, LINENS AND OTHER TEXTILES

Threadcycle! Donate all your unwanted or unusable textiles and clothing (except items that are wet, mildewed or contaminated with hazardous materials) for reuse and recycle. More information can be found at your.kingcounty.gov/solidwaste/ecoconsumer/threadcycle.asp



MEDICATIONS

Dispose of your unwanted medicines properly through a pharmacy or law enforcement take-back program for free. In Auburn, take your unwanted medicines to the Auburn Police Department, 340 E Main St., 253-931-3080.
