**Properly dispose of your household hazardous waste at the King County Wastemobile for FREE.** Household Hazardous Waste includes oil-based paint, stains, household cleaners, pesticides, motor oil, antifreeze, and more. **Location:** The Outlet Collection (Supermall), 1101 Outlet Collection DR SW, Auburn. The collection facility is on the backside of the mall between Nordstrom Rack and Sports Authority. Open every Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

### Unwanted Medicine Disposal (Free):

Take back old medicines (for human and pet) to the Auburn Police Department, 340 E. Main ST, 253-931-3080. Free anonymous drop-off.



### Sharps Disposal (Free):

Dispose of used needles and Sharps at the King County Public Health Center, 901 Auburn Way N, #A, 206-477-0600



### Used Oil Filters:

Take back used oil filters to your local automotive store for recycling.



# Moving In? Moving Out?

Whether you're packing or unpacking, check out these tips and resources to help you waste less, reuse, recycle more and dispose of hazardous waste properly.



## GET STARTED

To set up curbside garbage, recycling and compostables (yard waste, food & food-soiled paper) collection services, contact City of Auburn Utilities at 253-931-3038 or [Utilities@auburnwa.gov](mailto:Utilities@auburnwa.gov) January 2016



## PACK IT UP

- Need moving boxes? Instead of buying new, check for used boxes in your area on [www.Craigslist.org](http://www.Craigslist.org), [www.Freecycle.org](http://www.Freecycle.org) or a local moving company.
- Reuse what you've got. Use luggage and containers you already own to pack belongings.
- Rent reusable moving containers from companies like FrogBox, [www.frogbox.com](http://www.frogbox.com), 1-877-376-4269.
- Wrap fragile items in towels or small linens, reused bubble wrap or use newspaper and recycle it after the move.



## CLEAN IT OUT

**Dispose** of old, larger furniture and household items that are not reusable or recyclable at the King County Transfer Station, 35315 W. Valley Hwy, Algona, 206-477-4466.

**Extra garbage** put out for collection above the normal service level will be charged an additional fee. Save money and do the right thing by reusing and recycling as much as possible.

**Drop off** Styrofoam® blocks, packaging peanuts and bubble wrap for recycling at Styro Recycle, located at 23418 - 68th Ave S, Kent. Contact Styro Recycle at [www.styrorecycle.com](http://www.styrorecycle.com), 253-838-9555.

Most local mail houses will also accept packaging peanuts for reuse. Check with the City Solid Waste Department for upcoming recycling collection events at 253-931-3038 or visit the website at [www.auburnwa.gov/solidwaste](http://www.auburnwa.gov/solidwaste) and click on Upcoming Events (menu at left).

## RECYCLE RIGHT

### Cooking Oil:

Recycle cooking oil at the City of Auburn Les Gove Park collection container, 910 9th St SE, Auburn (south of the water spray park). Bring cooled, used fryer or cooking oil in a container that pours easily. Pour oil into the collection tank marked "General Biodiesel". Open 24/7.

### Moving Boxes:

Flatten and recycle in your curbside cart. If they won't fit in the cart, put in a box or can, label "RECYCLE", and they will be collected at no extra charge. DO NOT use plastic bags. Maximum cardboard size: 2 ft. x 3 ft. flattened.
