# Bulky Item Collection Event

Put items at your curbside **April 13 – 17** for pick up on your garbage collection day

Auburn's annual **RESIDENTIAL BULKY ITEM COLLECTION** is a once-a-year opportunity to clean house and get rid of your bulky items that are non-hazardous, non-liquid, non-recyclable, and non-reusable at the curb or alley.



## Who can participate?

- Residents who live in a single-family home, duplex or mobile home park within the Auburn City limits.
- Residents who are a customer of Waste Management.

## When is collection?

- Bulky item collection is **ONE DAY ONLY** on your GARBAGE collection day. Place items at the curb or alley by your garbage container for pickup by **7 a.m.**
- Be sure items are not blocking garbage or compostables containers. Regular garbage and compostable collection will proceed as normal during Bulky Item Collection week.

**ON BACK:** Collection guidelines and what items are accepted for collection.



## What if my items were not picked up?

- The Bulky Item Collection driver will leave an "OOPS TAG" for items not accepted. Please remove these items from the curbside or alley.
- If there is NO "OOPS TAG" and your items have not been picked up by 7 p.m., \*call the City of Auburn within 24 hours at 253-931-3038, option #2 to report a missed pickup.

*\*Mobile home park residents contact your property manager for missed collections.*

# BULKY ITEM COLLECTION GUIDELINES

**ONLY LARGE BULKY ITEMS** such as: a sofa, refrigerator, washer, dryer, microwave, dishwasher, hot water tank, stove, desk, table and chairs or BBQ.

## **GUIDELINES:**

- **LIMITED to ONE** of each type of item per household.
- **NO** small or miscellaneous items, garbage or yard waste.
- **NO** TVs, electronics, lumber or household construction materials.
- Remove doors on all appliances.
- **Empty & drain** of all fluids except for refrigerators and freezers (including motor oil, gasoline, hydraulic fluids, etc.).
- **PUT OUT AT YOUR OWN RISK.** Keep items not meant for pick up away from bulky items. The City of Auburn and Waste Management cannot be responsible for items picked up that were not meant for the Bulky Item Collection.
