Garbage Guidelines

Please bag all items.



GARBAGE TIPS

- Please bag all garbage.
- Double bag pet waste, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust and cold ashes.
- Please DO NOT put yard waste, liquids, hazardous waste or recycling in garbage.

There is a charge for extra garbage

Each garbage unit set out for collection that does not fit in the container with the lid closed and is above the normal service level listed on your utility account will be subject to **additional charges of \$11.22 per bag/box/can.**

Garbage collection is mandatory for properties billed by the City of Auburn. It is the responsibility of the homeowner or property manager to see that his/her tenants have adequate garbage service and containers.

Recycle Only

No food or liquids.
No plastic bags.

RECYCLING TIPS

- Empty clean recyclables out of bags and boxes into the cart so they can be easily sorted.
- No plastic bags! Recycle bags at your local grocery store.
- Flatten all cardboard (maximum size 2'x3')
- Put all recycling in your recycling cart.
- Recycling is collected every other week.

You can recycle extra at no cost! Put extra recycling in kraft bag, cardboard box or 32-gallon container with handles and lid. Please label "Recycle."

Compost Only

NO PLASTIC

Food Scraps



Meat, fish, dairy, fruit, vegetables, shells, bones, pasta, rice, eggshells, nutshells, bread, grains and leftovers

Uncoated Paper



Coffee grounds and filters, tea bags, uncoated paper (non-shiny), soiled paper bags, kitchen paper towels, paper napkins, non-coated paper plates, approved compostable packaging and loose shredded paper. Visit cedar-grove.com for approved compostable products.

Plants, Flowers and Yard Debris



Plants and flowers, landscape vegetation, grass clippings, weeds, twigs, leaves, branches (under 4 feet long, 4 inches in diameter), jack-o-lanterns and holiday trees (no flocking)

COMPOST TIPS

1. Collect food scraps and leftovers in a:
 - Colander or strainer
 - Paper grocery bag
 - Reusable plastic, metal, glass or ceramic container with lid
 - Approved compostable bag
2. Empty your collection container into the compostables cart frequently.
3. Layer food scraps with yard waste, newspaper or shredded paper to absorb liquids.

There is a charge for extra yard waste. Put extra yard waste in kraft paper bag, cardboard box, or 32-gallon container with handles and lid (65lb limit). Please label "Yard." **Do not** put food or food-soiled paper in extra yard waste bags or cans.

CONTAINER SET OUT GUIDELINES



Your garbage and compostables containers will be collected weekly. Recycling will be collected every other week on your garbage day.

- Place containers at the curb by 7 a.m.
- Place containers two (2) feet apart with lids opening toward the street.
- Place containers at least three (3) feet from obstructions such as cars, trees, fences, mailboxes. Our trucks need clear access to empty containers.
- Place wheels as close to the curb as possible.

NEW SERVICE

Garbage	10, 20, 35, 64 and 96-gallon
Recycling	35, 64 and 96-gallon
Compostables	35, 64 and 96-gallon

MISSING CONTAINERS

Please report any damaged or missing containers immediately to the City of Auburn Utilities at **253-931-3038**. A replacement container will be delivered in 3 – 5 business days, if possible.

NO credit will be given for missed collection due to missing container.

Winter Is Coming!

Collection Policy for Inclement Weather



Garbage: up to twice the regular amount of garbage will be collected on your next regularly scheduled collection day the following week for no additional charge.

Recycling: the next collection for recycling is on your regular collection day in two weeks. There is no charge for extra recyclables that don't fit in your cart.

Compostables: up to twice the regular amount of compostables will be collected on your next regularly scheduled collection day the following week for no additional charge.

Billing credits are not issued due to weather-delayed service.

Waste Management is committed to providing reliable collection for all customers. If severe weather conditions prevent the safe collection of garbage, recycling or compostables, please remove containers from the street at the end of the day.

Guidelines for Setting Out Extra Materials After a Weather Delay

For extra materials due to a weather-related missed collection, please follow these guidelines:

Extra Garbage

Place next to garbage container labeled "Garbage" in:

- Securely tied plastic bags
- 32-gal cans with handles & lid (65 lb limit)

Extra Recycling

Place next to recycling cart labeled "Recycling" in:

- Cardboard box
- 32-gal cans with handles & lid (65 lb limit)

No recycling in plastic bags.

Extra Yard Waste

Place next to compostables cart labeled "Yard Waste" in:

- Heavy paper yard bags (available at hardware stores)
- Reusable polywoven yard bags (available at hardware stores)
- 32-gal cans with handles & lids (65 lb limit)
- Bundles tied with twine (4'x2' limit)

No yard waste in plastic bags.
No food scraps in extra yard waste.
