March 1 – March 28 Auburn Valley Creative Arts Auburn Valley Creative Arts (AVCA) members display artwork of diverse media and inspiration. Participating artists include Susan Bischof Storey, Marie Lyndemere, Lela Brugger, Judy Ann Matthews, Roy Dilley, Joan Nicholson, Dan Norman, J.M. King, Amy Sie, Connie Reinicke, Penelope Evans and Mary Ellen Bowers.

March 30 – April 27 Thendara M. Kida-Gee & Zachary Kolden The photo collage of Thendara M. Kida-Gee and Silver Gelatin black and white photography of Zachary Kolden explore photography in dissimilar methods but with similarly striking results.

May 1 – May 30 Cal Capener As a lifelong resident of the State of Washington, artist Cal Capener's oil paintings focus primarily on landscapes of the Pacific Northwest and his travels abroad, as well as portraits, florals, animals and western scenes.

June 1 – June 27 David McCrae & Janice Wagner Artist David McCrae's artwork captures a transitory moment with his digital photography. A wilting flower is juxtaposed against black background forcing the viewer to contemplate the transient beauty of life. Working primarily in oils, artist Janice Wagner renders natural forms and collectable art objects in exacting realism. Using the play of light, textures, and patterns traditional still life paintings capture every detail.

June 29 – July 25 John A. Woodard John Woodard's large scale self-portrait oil paintings are variations of an exploration of self. Beginning with a drawing done in front of a concaved mirror, the mirror is held at a distance where the face is both partially in and out of focus. These works attempt to capture the out-of-focus quality and showcase the artists' emotional and physical expressions.

CHERYL SALLEE GALLERY (808 Ninth ST SE)

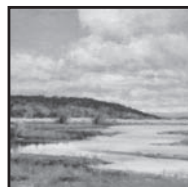
