Purpose of Program and Source of Funding

The primary purpose of this program is to provide support to arts-related projects and programs within the City of Auburn, to encourage the development and stability of local arts programs, as well as offer opportunities for local artists.

The City of Auburn Arts Commission allocates funding support it receives from 4Culture (Cultural Development Authority of King County) to community arts organizations and special projects through its Arts Sustained Support Program. All funds awarded through this program are dependent entirely on receipt of funds from 4Culture. Small arts-project funding (\$100-\$250 range) is available throughout the year through a separate application process.

Application Requirements

The Project Support Grant Program provides funding for arts related projects or programs, for the benefit of the residents of the City of Auburn, Washington.

Awards are typically \$500 to \$2,000. Basic requirements for applicants are as follows:

- Proposed projects must take place within the city limits of Auburn and serve/be completely accessible to all residents of Auburn.
- Private, by-invitation-only, or membership events do not qualify. All events/projects must be open to the general public.
- Projects must comply with all regulations of the United States of America, State of Washington, and City of Auburn.
- Those artists or organizations receiving funding through other City of Auburn programs or sponsorship may apply for funds through this program; however, priority is given to those organizations who are not already receiving funding support through any of the other City of Auburn program.

What kind of projects do not qualify?

- Scholarships, tuition assistance, or other student support.
- Underwritten project sponsorships, or subsidy of tickets.
- Projects which support religious activities or political organizations.

- Projects that exclusively or primarily benefit the membership of the organization, or those that preclude reasonable access by the general public.

Projects meeting criterion shall be evaluated according to the following:

- A goal of the Auburn Arts Commission is to enhance appreciation of the arts and provide as broad a spectrum and access to arts programming as possible to all residents of Auburn. Consideration is given to those projects that demonstrate how these Commission priorities are addressed.
- Community outreach, or involvement, including partnerships with other organizations, or public participation, with an implementation plan and evaluation of the impact of the project will be given additional consideration.
- Projects must take place within the 2017 calendar year

Panel Review

- Eligible applications are reviewed by a peer panel selected for their knowledge and/or expertise in the arts, familiarity with the Auburn community and their ability to interpret policies and review criteria.
- Amount granted may not be for the exact amount requested.

All published materials and announcements regarding the project must state: "This project made possible through the support of the City of Auburn and 4Culture King County Lodging Tax." Promotional credit must be clearly prominent and submitted as part of the evaluation.
