PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This volunteer effort will entail planting and mulching approximately 8,000 native plants at the Fenster Nature Park along the Green River. The plantings are a part of a larger levee setback project just completed in cooperation with the City of Auburn and King County. The project will improve salmon habitat, and provide floodplain protection from the Green River.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Roster of volunteers with waiver (use attached form)
- Shovels, pitch forks, buckets, & wheelbarrows
- Gardening or work gloves

CITY WILL PROVIDE:

- Coffee, Juice, granola bars, and small pastries
- Other project materials as may be needed
