PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Help celebrate Earth Day during Auburn's largest volunteer event. Clean Sweep 2016 will focus on clean-up, environmental restoration, and beautification efforts in Auburn. Volunteer groups will work on general clean-up, landscaping, planting, weeding and other projects at various park, environmental sites, and other locations around Auburn. Volunteers can either choose to participate in a specific project or can ask to be assigned to any project, in which case your group will be assigned where the most volunteer support is needed.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Roster of volunteers with waiver (use attached form)
- Tools based on volunteer assignment (to be determined once registered)
- Gardening or work gloves
- Broom for ceremonial sweep along Main Street sidewalks

CITY WILL PROVIDE:

- Breakfast at City Hall
- Instruction Sheets for projects at each location
- Garbage Bags
- Other project materials as may be needed

PARKING:

Parking is available around City Hall and will be available near each project location.

RESTROOMS:

Restrooms will be open in the morning at City Hall and port-o-lets will be available at each project site.
