Benefits of Compost

Compost-enriched soil can reduce erosion, alleviate soil compaction and help control diseases and pest infestation in plants. Compost can increase plant production, reduce the use of chemical fertilizers and conserve natural resources.

- Purchaser must live within the city limits of Auburn
- Purchaser agrees to be contacted by and cooperate with the City of Auburn Composting Specialist via email, phone and/or site-visit to track the success of purchasers composting program.
- One bin purchase per household (address)
