About the Happy Paws Pet Vendor Event

Date: Saturday, May 22, 2021

Time: 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Location: Les Gove Park, 910 Ninth Street SE

Event profile: A small-scale pet vendor event to be held in place of our traditional Petpalooza festival. The event site will be completely fenced, so number of attendees can be monitored in accordance with state guidelines. To follow social distancing guidelines, we would have one entrance and one exit. Each vendor booth will have social distancing indicators. Vendor booths will be 6-8' apart and we could likely accommodate approximately 45 vendors. Customers will not be allowed 'inside' your booth, thus a U-shaped set-up is mandatory (e.g. tables on outside and staff member on the inside).

Selection Criteria and Booth Information:

- Booths are uncovered 12' x 12' space. Vendors must supply their own materials (canopies, tables, chairs, signs, etc.) and are responsible for all set-up and take-down. Vendors are required to stay in their assigned space and are required to stay for the duration of the event.
- Payment must accompany application. Unapproved applications and payments may be returned to you.
- Any vendor that has animals on-site (for display or adoption) must provide the City of Auburn with a copy of their liability insurance. Accepted activity vendors (and those required vendors) must provide proof of insurance, by April 30, 2021 for two million (\$2,000,000) dollars naming the City of Auburn as additional insured.
- Craft Artists must submit photographs or images of your work. Email to: events@auburnwa.gov with Happy Paws event in Subject line. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you mail photographs that you want returned.
- Electricity is not available. If you're bringing your own source of temporary power, you're required to obtain and L&I Permit and schedule your inspection. Please contact L&I directly (a minimum of 10 working days prior to the event) at 206-835-1000.
- The City of Auburn does not require a percentage of sales. Vendors keep all of their revenue.
- There is a limit of 2 personnel inside a booth at one time (unless all members are from the same family unit). Face masks/coverings will be required to be worn at all times. All guidelines pertaining to COVID-19 guidelines will be strictly enforced.
- Complete event information will be **e-mailed** the week of May 10.
- Rules, regulations and event details are subject to change based on State of Washington COVID-19 related guidelines.

General Vendor Definitions and Fees

Please check the appropriate fees. Enter quantities where necessary. We may be unable to accommodate requests for multiple booth spaces.

Non-Profit/Rescue Vendor or Animal Club: Any pet-related, non-profit agency or club. Non-profit certificate must accompany application form to receive non-profit rate. Vendors in this category are limited to no more than two booth spaces.	\$15 - on or before April 16 \$18 - after April 16	\$

INSURANCE – The City does not maintain insurance that will respond to claims against the applicant arising out of the use of the booth by the applicant, its members, or those attending the event. Depending on the type of event you are planning, and the activity and risk level of your group, you may be required to obtain bodily injury and property damages liability insurance in accordance with City policy, name the City as an additional insured on the policy, and be responsible for obtaining said insurance. After reviewing this application, the City will determine whether you must obtain liability insurance.

RELEASE – The Applicant is fully aware that there are special dangers and risks inherent in this activity, including, but not limited to, serious physical injury, death or other harmful consequences, that may arise directly or indirectly from participation in this activity and harm the Applicant listed above or its individual members. Being informed of these risks and in consideration of being allowed to participate, we assume all risk of injury, damage, and harm to any member arising from participation. The Applicant agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the City, its officials, employees, volunteers, and agents from all causes of action, claims, and fees arising from its participation, except those arising from the City's sole negligence, and waive any right of recovery against the City for personal injury, death or other consequences occurring from participation in this activity. I agree that I have authority to enter into this agreement for the Applicant. I also agree I have read and agree to the conditions outlined in the "Selection Criteria and Booth Information" on the reverse side of this application.

COVID-19 WAIVER LANGUAGE - 1.
