The Curb Competition is for entries that want to honor veterans, but don't meet the requirements to participate in the parade.

The purpose of Auburn's Veterans Parade is to positively focus on honoring our country's veterans and active military personnel. Through our parade, we focus recognition on congressionally-recognized Veteran Service Organizations and their auxiliaries, the military and reserve military, National Guard and ROTC.

This signed application must be submitted and approved in order to be judged in the Curb Competition at Auburn's Veterans Parade. Upon receipt, a confirmation will be sent via email. Complete event instructions will follow at the end of October. Those participating in the Curb Competition may set-up and decorate a 12 ft. long x 5 ft. deep section of curb to honor our veterans. Stay for the parade to salute our veterans and active military personnel!

Participants must set-up along the parade route between Auburn Ave. and A St. SE and E St. NE. Set-up is held from 7 a.m. – 10 a.m. Judging is held from 10 a.m. – 10:45 a.m. Awards will be given in three categories: Best Curb Appeal, Most Patriotic and Best Salute to Veterans.
